The University Senate was formed in 1970 to provide a center of discussion for those elements of the university which had been dissatisfied with their role in university policy-making. Its predecessor, the Constituent Assembly (see Sheila Tobias' History of the Constituent Assembly, #54/1/1323) provided the preliminary organization.

This collection consists of 13 16" boxes (1-13), one 4" legal size box (14) and one 3" letter size box (15). The first Senate material is in boxes 1-3; second Senate in is boxes 5-8; third Senate is in boxes 9-11 and fourth Senate in boxes 12-13. Box 4 contains computer printouts of the elections of the first through the fourth Senate. Box 14 contains computer printouts for the fourth and fifth Senate. Box 15 contains the Speaker's correspondence only from the fifth Senate.

Within each Senate the material is roughly ordered as follows. The correspondence, minutes, reports, rosters and legislation of the Senate as a whole comes first. Next comes the speaker's correspondence. The last large grouping is that of the Senate committees. Important standing committees include the Campus Life Committee, the Executive Committee, the Committee on Committees, the Judiciary Committee and the Committee on Admissions and Financial Aids. There are several special committees to consider such topics as the physical education graduation requirement, the lettuce boycott and the relationship of the university to its employees. These special committees show a tendency to become standing committees. The material from each senate committee or subcommittee is divided by physical type. The majority is correspondence, minutes, reports, and legislation.
