- 1. April 8, 1925-April 22, 1925. Correspondence between Alfred A. Knopf and Carl L. Becker. In the letters Knopf urges Becker to write a book on Benjamin Disraeli (Carl Van Doren made the suggestion to Knopf) but Becker politely turns down the offer.
- 2. April 8, 1939-February 5, 1942. Correspondence between Alfred Knopf and Carl Becker. Knopf is eager to publish works by Becker, but a series of articles are committed to the Yale University Press. An agreement is then made by Becker to publish The Declaration of Independence and much of the correspondence deals with changes or deletions in the manuscript before publication.
- 3. March 23, 1943-April 15, 1944. General correspondence between Alfred Knopf and Carl Becker. Mentioned is Becker's Penrose Lecture on Jefferson which appeared in the American Historical Review and the working over, publishing, and expected income (with suggestions from Knopf) of Becker's new book entitled, How New Will the Better World Be? The circulating by Knopf of advance copies of the book to notable people like Samuel Eliot Morrison, Arthur M. Schlesinger, Jr., Archibald MacLeish, Carl Van Doren, and U.S. Supreme Court Justices Black, Frankfurter, Jackson, Douglas and Stone.
- 4. May 12, 1944-Dec. 26, 1944. Correspondence between Carl Becker and Alfred Knopf, and between Alfred Knopf, E. Blythe Stason (Dean of the University of Michigan Law School) and George H. Sabine of Cornell University. The letters deal with the publishing of Carl Becker's five William W. Cook Lectures on American Institutions: Lecture 1, The American Political Tradition, Lecture II, Freedom of Learning and Teaching, Lecture IV, Constitutional Government, Lecture V, Private Economic Enterprise.
- 5. Correspondence between Alfred Knopf and Carl Becker, and Alfred Knopf and E. Blythe Stason, all concerning Becker's Michigan lectures (The Cook Lectures) and the publication and contract for the manuscript, "Freedom and Responsibility in the American Way of Life." January 1, 1945-April 10, 1945.
