EDWARD EGGLESTON (1837-1902) was the first of the Midwestern local colorists and the founder of the "Hoosier School" of regional fiction. He came to the writing of fiction from a religious upbringing that created in him a distrust of fictional literature in general, and an antipathy to the basic "untruths" of sentimental-domestic novels and historical romances. Eggleston ranged widely as a writer, producing poetry, topical essays, literary criticism, humorous sketches, travel articles, reminiscences, books of history and instruction, memoirs of departed friends, and satire, in addition to short stories and novels. It was his fiction, however, that brought him to national attention, and according to William P. Randel, in the writing of it, he placed himself squarely among the pioneer realists who abjured the pre-Civil War romanticism and created, or invented, an indigenous kind of fiction. It might be enough to recall *The Hoosier School-Master*, in Eggleston's own words, the "file-leader of Western dialect fiction," but so limited an acquaintance with his writing would give an incomplete measure of what he could do, and what he did.

WILLIAM P. RANDEL is Professor of English at the University of Maine at Orono and author of *Edward Eggleston: Author of the Hoosier School-Master* (1946), a full-length biography, and *Edward Eggleston* in the Twayne United States Authors Series (1963).
