Summary: Correspondence, mimeographed pamphlets and other printed material; photographs, and scrapbooks concerning Babcock's career as a county agent in Cattaraugus and Tompkins Counties, New York, as an executive in the New York State Farm Bureau, the Grange League Federation (G.L.F.) and related organizations (extensive), the New York State Agricultural Conference Board, the Federal Farm Board, Central Bank for Cooperatives, National Council of Farmer Cooperatives, and the New York State Emergency Food Commission, as a member or consultant of various New York State, Federal, and non-governmental boards and committees, and as professor of marketing and later trustee of Cornell University. Includes correspondence with editors and publishers of numerous agricultural and other journals and with manufacturers of farm equipment, chiefly relating to agricultural research and education, to the promotion of effective farm organizations, and to state and national politics as they pertain to agriculture. Correspondents include Ezra Taft Benson, Edmund Ezra Day, Thomas E. Dewey, Victor Emanuel, Herbert H. Lehman, and Thomas E. Milliman.

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BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Howard E. Babcock, farm cooperative leader and agricultural educator, was born on a farm near Gilbertsville in Chenango County, N.Y., the only child of Mary Emma (Donahue) and Howard Worden Babcock. His father, a native of Vermont, was descended from a family which had settled in Rhode Island before the American Revolution; his mother was born in New York City, the daughter of a Protestant Irish father and an English mother. Babcock early shared in farm chores. After graduating from the Gilbertsville high school, he spent two years in farm work before entering Syracuse University. There he planned to study law but became interested in botany instead.

After receiving his B.A. degree in 1911, Babcock took a summer course at Cornell University to qualify for teaching vocational agriculture in high schools, a newly opening field. His first positions were at Albion, N.Y. (1911-1912), and at the Elmira Free Academy (1912-1913), where he was head of the biology department. At that time the movement for promoting better farming practices through demonstration work in the field, begun in 1903 by Seaman A. Knapp, was gaining a foothold in New York. Aided by state and federal funds, a system of county demonstration agents grew up, linked to the extension department of the State College of Agriculture at Cornell and supported by county organizations of farmers known as farm bureaus. Babcock in 1913 became county agent for Cattaraugus County. His work was of such high quality that within a few months he was called to Ithaca as county agent for Tompkins County. On Oct. 23, 1913, he married Hilda Wall Butler, who had been a fellow teacher in Albion. They had three children: Howard Edward, Barbara Elizabeth, and John Butler.

Babcock became assistant state leader of county agents in 1914 and state leader two years later. The farm bureau system expanded rapidly under his direction, and in 1917 he fostered the establishment of the New York State Federation of County Farm Bureaus (later called the New York Farm Bureau Federation), of which he was secretary until 1921. From 1918 to 1920 he was also secretary of the New York Conference Board of Farm Organizations. While serving as state food commissioner during World War I, Babcock had become interested, as he later wrote, in "what farmers might do for themselves through a cooperative." Thus, in 1920, he was instrumental in having the Board of Farm Organizations sponsor the founding of the Cooperative Grange League Federation Exchange (the G.L.F.) as a statewide cooperative purchasing organization. Babcock was one of the original directors of the G.L.F., and took charge of the "million-dollar" stock selling drive, which was a phenomenal success. He gave up his position as state county agent leader in 1920 to develop his own expanding farming interests near

Ithaca. Later in the year he was persuaded by George F. Warren, head of the Department of Agricultural Economics at Cornell University, to take a position there as professor of marketing. His innovative and stimulating courses attracted a large following of men who were soon to become key leaders in the G.L.F. and in agriculture.

When the G.L.F. faltered after two years of uncertain and inept management, Babcock was drafted to take charge as general manager. Under his leadership, it soon became the outstanding regional purchasing cooperative in the United States, and its pathfinding procedures made it the model for cooperatives throughout the nation. Babcock expanded the field sales force, upgraded the system of local distributive agencies, and made imaginative use of advertising to interest farmers in G.L.F. feed, seed, and fertilizer. He also established vital and lasting links with academic specialists in rural sociology, marketing, and agricultural sciences at Cornell and other land-grant universities. Babcock managed the G.L.F. from 1922 to 1932, and again from 1935 to 1937. He continued to give direction to the organization's marketing, research, and educational programs until 1945, by which time the G.L.F. had developed a business volume of \$174 million and assets of over \$34 million.

Babcock regarded the G.L.F. not only as a purchasing and marketing cooperative, but also as a great research and educational institution. Thus he helped establish the "University of the G.L.F.," which became the G.L.F. School of Cooperative Administration, and served as director from 1940 to 1943. This was the first major personnel training school sponsored by an American cooperative organization. Babcock also served on the board of trustees of Cornell University from 1930 until his death. As chairman, 1939-1946, he presided over the university's wartime expansion, and, working with President Edmund E. Day and with New York Governor Thomas E. Dewey, was instrumental in founding the Schools of Nutrition, Business Administration, and Labor Relations. Babcock's leadership, along with that of the first director, Leonard A. Maynard, made the School of Nutrition one of the best in the world.

Slender and bespectacled, Babcock was a man of restless energy, intellectual drive, and saving common sense. These qualities, together with his lucidity in oral and written expression, made him a national leader in American agriculture as early as 1919, when he helped organize the American Farm Bureau Federation. In 1933 he was called to Washington by the Roosevelt administration to help unscramble the Federal Farm Board and put the Farm Credit Administration on a sound operating basis. He was one of the first directors of the Farm Credit Administration's Central Bank for Cooperatives. As president of the National Council of Farmer Cooperatives in 1941, Babcock helped to mobilize the work of cooperatives to meet wartime

agricultural needs. Many honors came his way, including honorary doctorates from Syracuse University and Michigan State University. In 1946 the American Farm Bureau Federation granted Babcock its highest award for "Distinguished Service to American Agriculture."

Babcock made his own farm, "Sunnygables," something of an experimental laboratory in promoting advancements like grass silage, assembly-line milking, home freezers in the interest of better nutrition, and interchangeable wheels for farm equipment. While hospitalized in New York City following a minor operation, he died of a heart attack at the age of sixty one. He was buried in East Lawn Cemetery, Ithaca, N.Y. Babcock had a profound and beneficial influence on the agricultural character of the United States, both through his demonstration of the possibilities and values of strong democratic cooperative organizations, and in his pioneering leadership in the fields of animal and human nutrition and in improved farm business and cultural practices.

PROVENANCE AND ARRANGEMENT

The Howard E. Babcock papers arrived at the Department of Manuscripts and University Archives on 12 March 1956. The photographs and negatives arrived at a later time. Two cubic feet of Cornell University Trustees Proceedings volumes were removed from the collection.

In processing the collection, Babcock's original topical divisions and folder headings have been retained. The first two of the five series are divided into topical or chronological subseries. Within several of the subseries, additional topical headings may have alphabetical sequences. Researchers should also note that both chronological and reverse-chronological orders were used in Babcock's offices, and these have been maintained.

An IBM personal computer using WordPerfect software was used to generate the index from a selection of names, topics, and organizations derived from the folder headings.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Howard E. Babcock Collection consists of extensive correspondence, printed and mimeographed pamphlets, bulletins, reprints of articles and speeches, circular letters, minutes of meetings, photographs, negatives, scrapbooks, and miscellaneous other papers of Howard E. Babcock, agricultural economist, executive, educator, writer, and farm owner. Correspondence and other papers relate to Babcock's activities while a student at Syracuse University (B.A. 1911) and as an alumnus; as county agent, Cattaraugus and Tompkins Counties (1913-1914); as assistant state director, secretary, and finally state director of the New York State Farm Bureau Organization (1914-1919); as general manager, Cooperative Grange League Federation Exchange (G.L.F.); president, Cooperative G.L.F. Holding Corporation; president, Cooperative G.L.F. Products, Inc.; director, The G.L.F. School of Cooperative Administration; director of research, G.L.F. (G.L.F. correspondence extensive, 1922-1945); as secretary, New York State Agricultural Conference Board (1917-1921); as member, New York State Food Conservation Commission (1917-1918), the Business Advisory Council of the United States Department of Commerce (1944-1945), National Research Advisory Committee (1946+), Governor Franklin D. Roosevelt's Agricultural Advisory Committee, the New York State Council of Farms and Markets, and the Guernsey and Aberdeen-Angus Breeders' Association; as assistant Chairman, Federal Farm Board (1933); director, Central Bank for Cooperatives (1933-1939); special consultant, Farm Credit Administration; president, National Council of Farmer Cooperatives (1943); chairman, New York State Emergency Food Commission (1943); and as professor of marketing, Cornell University (1920-1922), trustee (1930-1950), and chairman (1940-1947) of the Board of Trustees of Cornell University. Papers pertaining to Cornell University include extensive correspondence, minutes of meetings, reports, and newspaper clippings; collection also contains correspondence with publishers and editors of numerous agricultural and other journals, including American Agriculturist, American Farming, Country Gentleman, Farm Journal, Rural New Yorker, Saturday Evening Post, and Successful Farming; and copies of articles contributed by Babcock; other correspondence and miscellaneous papers pertain to family matters, experimental work with re-rigged farm equipment, grass silage, and home freezers on Babcock's farms (c. 1930-1950); contacts with numerous business firms concerned with agriculture, including the AVCO Manufacturing Company, Allis-Chalmers, Allied Mills, and many others; promotion of effective farm organizations, especially cooperatives; improved farm practices, agricultural research and education, nutrition, food processing, preservation and

distribution, and state ^{and} national politics, especially with regard to agricultural issues. Included are correspondence and other papers concerning Monroe C. Babcock, Neal Dow Becker, Earl W.
