

Randall, Henry Stephens, 1811-1876. Papers, c. 1844-1876.

Agriculturist, educator, author. These additional papers [see 1954-1958 Report] consist largely of letters to Randall from sheep ranchers in Illinois, Michigan, New York, Ohio, and Texas concerning the raising of sheep and sheep diseases, the wool tariff, and the activities of wool growers' and manufacturers' associations, some of which were written to him in his capacity as Sheep Husbandry Department editor (1864-1867) of Moore's Rural New Yorker; also, letters received while he was Cortland County Superintendent of Schools (1843-1847) and while he was Secretary of State and ex officio Superintendent of Common Schools in New York State (1851-1853), from office seekers and others desiring his aid and concerning the New York City school tax due New York State, school redistricting in Onondaga County, the need for Indian education, and other subjects; letters concerning Democratic delegates to New York county and state conventions and other party matters; and occasional correspondence of his wife, Jane Rebecca Polhemus Randall.
