SCOTT FAMILY. Papers, 1861–1875; 11 in. Correspondence (1862–1872) and legal papers (1861–1875) of Wiley H. Scott and family of Nineveh and Unadilla. Correspondence is primarily between various members of the family, particularly the sons of Wiley Scott, Emmet, Silas, Edwin, and Arthur, relating to their business ventures, such as the "Scott House," a hotel in Nineveh; the Scott Brewery in Unadilla; a contract for the grading and masonry of twenty-two miles of road from Peru to Rochester; and to various cases in which the Scotts were involved. Also included are five memorandum books (1870–1875) of Edwin W. Scott, four account books (1863–1874) for the "Scott House," one account book (1870–1872) for the Scott Brewery, one ledger (1871–1872) belonging to Arthur L. Correspondence (1862-1872), legal papers (1861-1875) and account and memo books (1863-1875) of Wiley H. Scott and family of Nineveh and Unadilla, New York.

Correspondence is mainly between various members of the family, especially the sons of Wiley Scott, named Edwin, Emmet, Silas and Arthur, relating primarily to their business ventures, such as the Scott House, a hotel in Nineveh; the Scott Brewery in Unadilla; a contract for the grading and masonry of 22 miles of road from Peru to Rochester. Legal papers pertain to various cases in which the Scotts were involved, such as a land ejectment suit in Nineveh in 1867, and a contract violation suit in which they were the defendants in 1875. Collection also includes five memo books (1870-1875) of Edwin W. Scott, four account books (1863-1874) for the Scott House, one account book (1870-1872) for the Scott Brewery, one ledger (1871-1872) belonging to Arthur L. Scott, and one Day Book (1865-1868) with entries pertaining to transactions in Unadilla and Nineveh and marked as belonging to "G.S.M.

Scott. and concerns various business nterprises which they undertook, such as the "Scott House", a hotel in Nineveh, N.Y., the Scott Brewery in Unadilaa, road building in the mid-west, and various legal cases in which they were involved, as a land ejectment suit in Nineveh in 1867, and a contract violation suit in which they were the defendants in 1875. The Scotts were neighbors of the Hobbs Family and evidently J.W. Hobbs, and later G.W. Hobbs, acted as their legal counsel. These papers relating to the Scott family were remove from the Hobbs Bros. Papers (1641) and a few more relative letters are to be found in the post-nineteen hundred correspondence of that collection.
