

Record of births and deaths of patients, kept by Dr. D. C. Rodenhurst, a general practitioner of Philadelphia, New York, 1 vol., 1880-1944 (restricted); Rodenhurst's scrapbook of newspaper clippings (marriage notices, obituaries, articles on medicine, etc.), snapshots and photographs, some unidentified, letters, programs, and other items, 1 vol., 1911-1945; 7 unmounted photographs, including several of Dr. and Mrs. Rodenhurst; loose newspaper clippings, many dated 1946-1959 and presumably collected by Mrs. Rodenhurst; also, on microfilm [same reel as # 1992], newspaper clippings of 18 articles written anonymously by the doctor for The North Country Advance, 1944-1945, and containing his recollections of Philadelphia as it was around 1880; and published items as follows: Samuel Hopkins Adams' The Great American Fraud (Press of the American Medical Association: Chicago, 1907) and annual reports of the New York and New England Railway Surgeons, 2 vols., 1917, 1919.
