Summary: Papers of Louis John Taber, dealing mainly with his interest in the Grange and in politics, and including correspondence, speeches, and various publications. Subjects include his work as Master of the National Grange, 1923-1941; his participation in the International Institute of Agriculture Conference, 1926; his campaign as the Republican candidate for U.S. Senator from Ohio, 1932; his recommendation for the post of Secretary of Agriculture, 1932; his opposition to many New Deal programs; the Farm Bureau-Grange controversy, 1939; his work on several federal agricultural commissions; and early Grange history. Also, correspondence and other records of the Farmers and Traders Life Insurance Company, Syracuse, 1926-1958; files pertaining to the operation of joint-stock land banks, 1922-1947; correspondence as Director of Agriculture for the State of Ohio, and related speeches, reports, and printed material, 1921-1923; diaries, 1907-1957; photographs and personal correspondence, including papers relating to his work with national and international civic and relief organizations; and family papers and MS. and printed material concerning the Taber-Pickett, Bailey family genealogy, 1844 - 1901.

TABER, LOUIS JOHN, 1878-1960. Papers, 1844-[1897-1959]; 33 ft. Agriculturist. These papers deal mainly with Taber's interest in the Grange and in politics. The first group (1874-1959) pertains largely to his work as Grand Master of the National Grange (1923-1941) and include correspondence with or concerning the Farmers' Union, the American Farm Bureau Federation, the National Council of Farm Cooperatives, the Grange League Federation (Ithaca), and other farmers' organizations; the Ohio Grange and other state granges; the Farm Bureau-Grange controversy (1939); colleges of agriculture; Charles M. Gardner and other farm paper editors; state governors, U.S. Senators, Cabinet members, and Presidents Herbert Hoover and Franklin D. Roosevelt; also includes speeches by Taber, revealing his personal political and economic philosophy and the viewpoint and stand of the Grange on various public issues; five letters (1875-1877) signed by Oliver Hudson Kelley and other papers pertaining to early Grange history; Journals of Proceedings of Annual Sessions of the National Grange (1873-1888, 1890-1959) and other related publications. The second group pertains largely to Taber's work as a private citizen for the Republican Party; his participation in the International Institute of Agriculture Conference (1926); his campaign as the Republican candidate for United States Senator from Ohio (1932); his recommendation for the post of Secretary of Agriculture (1932); opposition to many New Deal programs; and official work on several federal agricultural commissions; it includes correspondence with Ezra Taft Benson, Richard E. Byrd, Calvin Coolidge, Thomas E. Dewey, Robert A. Taft, Henry A. Wallace, Claude R. Wickard, and Harry S. Truman. In addition to these two major categories, the papers include correspondence and other records (1926-1958) pertaining to the Farmers and Traders Life Insurance Company (Syracuse, New York), of which Taber was a founder, vice-president, and president; files pertaining to the operation of joint-stock land banks (1922-1947); correspondence as Director of Agriculture for the State of Ohio and related speeches, reports, and printed material (1921-1923); diaries (1907-1951), photographs, and personal correspondence, including papers relating to his work for the Ohio Council of Churches, CARE and other national and international civic or relief organizations; and family papers and MS. and printed material concerning the Taber-Pickett-Bailey family genealogy (1844-1901). TABER, LOUIS JOHN, President, Farmers and Traders Life Insurance Company, Syracuse, New York, Past Master of The National Grange 1923 to 1941. He was born at Mt. Pleasant, Ohio, September 19, 1878, the son of Joseph J. and Maryh (Pickett) Taber. He was educated in the public schools and at Olney College, Barmsville, Ohio. On October 27th, 1909 he married Edna Bailey. They have two sons, John Paul and Francis Bailey. Mr. Taber began farming at the age of 14, at the time of his father's death, and later was one of the organizers of the first co-operative marketing and selling dairy associations in Ohio. He was one of the organizers of his local Grange in 1899 and has served as Lecturer and Master of the Ohio State Grange. From 1923 to 1941 he served as Master of The National Grange, holding this position longer than any other Master. Mr. Taber helped organize The Farmers and Traders Life Insurance Company at Syracuse, New York. He was elected Vice President in 1914. He is Director of The Grange Automobile Liability Company and The National Grange Fire Insurance Company. He is also Director and Vice President of the New York Joint Stock Land Bank and the National Livestock Marketing Association.

Mr. Taber served on President Wilson's Wheat Price Committee in 1917, and was a member of the Hoover Food Administration and the Ohio Council of Defense during the World War No. 1. He was a member of President Harding's Agricultural Conference in 1922 and President Coolidge's Agricultural Commission in 1924. He was American Delegate to the International Institute of Agriculture at Rome, Italy in 1926. Mr. Taber served as Director of Agriculture for Ohio in 1921 and ¹⁹²² 1923 and as a member of the Ohio State Library Board and a Trustee of the Ohio Experiment Station. He assisted in the organization of the National Agricultural Conference and was its first Chairman. He is also a member of the Committee on Economic Security, by appointment of President Roosevelt. Mr. Taber is Trustee and Secretary-Treas. of the National Highway Users Conference, also Vice President and Director of The National Farm Chemurgic Council. He is Trustee of the National Tax Foundation and a member of the National Committee on Rural Scouting of the Boy Scouts of America. In 1941 Mr. Taber was appointed by Secretary of Agriculture Wickard on the National Agricultural War Committee. He was appointed by Governor Bricker of Ohio as a member of the Ohio War Council and the Ohio Agricultural War Board. He is President of the Ohio Council of Churches.

The Louis J. Taber Papers

The Louis J. Taber Papers consist of nineteen 16" boxes and eight miscellaneous (non-CRH) boxes of papers, pamphlets, photographs, and souvenirs, covering the period from around 1870 to 1958. The bulk of the material covers the years 1920 to 1950. There is no logical order ~~with~~ within the boxes or the folders (although the material in the folders appears to have been chronologically arranged at some time). After a preliminary survey of the entire collection, I would like to propose the following method of arrangement:

I. GRANGE

Since between 9 to 11 boxes of the material concerns Taber's work as Grand Master of the National Grange (1923-1941), I feel that this material should be collected together. The papers are mainly the Master's correspondence and speeches. Also, the majority of the pamphlets (estimated 5 boxes) are on the Grange.

II. POLITICAL

I feel that this category is necessary to differentiate political matter from that of the Grange due to the supposed non-political nature of the Grange. In addition to Taber's work as a private citizen for the Republican Party (including his candidacy for the Ohio Senatorial nomination in 1932, his recommendation as a possible Secretary of Agriculture in 1932 under Hoover, and his opposition to many New Deal programs), I would include his official work on several federal agricultural commissions and his participation in The International Institute of Agriculture Conference in 1926, as political activities.

III. FARMERS' AND TRADERS' LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

In spite of the insurance company's direct connection with the Grange, its importance in Taber's career (with his 1941 retirement as National Master, Taber assumed the active presidency of this company) and the large amount of material (about 6 boxes) make another division necessary.

IV. PERSONAL

This category is necessary in order to distinguish Taber's private business (farm accounts and stocks), travel souvenirs (postcards, pictures, programs, and diaries), and family correspondence with his wife, Edna Bailey Taber, and sons, Paul and Francis (Pete), from his public activities. I also feel that Taber's work on various committees and community activities, like the Boy Scouts of America, The National Highway Users, and Ohio Council of Churches, should be included in this category.

V. PHOTOGRAPHS

There are at least 2 boxes of photos, many unidentified, of family groups and of Grange Conventions.

VI. PAMPHLETS

The approximately 5 boxes of pamphlets would most profitably be divided into categories similar to those necessary for the papers. The large number of duplicates (more than 2 copies) have been separated from the others.

VII. NEWSPAPERS

At least one and a half boxes of newspapers (mostly Taber's home town weekly, The Barnesville Enterprise) and thousands of clippings pertaining to Taber and his family are unarranged.

VIII. ITEMS OF SPECIAL INTEREST

1. Grange Historical Material: original letters to Rev. S. H. Ellis from O. H. Kelley and other founders of the Grange, 1875-1877.
