Congressman, Howard W. Robison practiced law in Owego, N.Y., served as county attorney of Tioga County, N.Y. from 1946 until 1956 when he was elected as a Republican to the Eighty-fifth Congress to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of W. Sterling Cole; he was reelected and served in the House of Representatives until his retirement in 1974.

Summary: Correspondence, invitations, other personal papers, bills, press releases, and clippings from years in office as a member of the House of Representatives. Papers include files relating to campaigns and elections, constituent requests, general files, files relating to bills, invitations, files relating to military and social security cases, military academies, veterans, gun control, the Vietnam War and the draft, aging and senior citizens, and files relating to local issues such as post offices, local airports, floods, interns, federally-funded projects, and Cornell University.

Also, tapes of "Robison Reports," 1968-1974, interviews on national events, John T. Calkins, interviewer.

Restricted for 30 years from date of transfer. Access to the correspondence and papers in advance of the 30 year limitation requires the written permission of the heirs of Howard Robison.

Case files are available to legitimate scholars with the understanding that the identity of individuals in these files is not to be made public. Reference can be made to individual cases, but only on an anonymous basis.

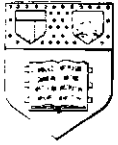

ROBISON, HOWARD WINFIELD

A Representative from New York; born in Owego, Tioga County, N. Y., October 30, 1915; attended the public schools of Owego, N. Y.; graduated from Cornell University in 1937 and from the law school of the same university in 1939; was admitted to the bar in 1939 and commenced the practice of law in Owego, N. Y.; during World War II served in the United States Army Counter Intelligence Corps 1942-1946; county attorney of Tioga County from 1946 until elected to Congress; elected as a Republican to the Eighty-fifth Congress to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of W. Sterling Cole; reelected to the Eighty-sixth Congress and served from January 14, 1958, to January 3, 1961. Reelected to the Eighty-seventh Congress.
