#### PRICE FAMILY GENEALOGY

(Compiled by David Price, March 5, 1983)

Samuel Price "came and settled" in New Jersey sometime around the 1740s. "Came and settled" suggests that he came from Europe; probably Wales, as Price is a Welsh name. He may have come from elsewhere, however.

Rice Price, son of Samuel, was born in 1753, and died (according to my memory of a document I cannot now find) sometime around 1815. He was responsible for clearing much of the land around Westfield, NJ. For reasons unknown he had a habit of cutting trees high above the ground, and years later local people would recognize a field of tall stumps as having been "Rice-Priced." He married Phoebe Clark (d. 1848 or 1849), daughter of the keeper of the Westfield Tavern, and (if my memory of the aforementioned document serves), later inherited the business. As an old man, he was fond of telling people that the stone doorstep had been cracked when hit by a cannon ball fired during the American Revolution. Rice and Pho ebe had eight children: Jonas, Phineas, Samuel, Jacob, William, Mary, Rhoday, and Hannah. Phineas (b. 1789) wrote a book (which I have seen, but whose name I do not have) that contains some genealogical and biographical information. Mary married a Kent; Rhoday, a Pooten; and Hannah, a Towen.

William Price (Feb. 27, 1797--Jan. 21, 1875), son of Rice, married Sarah Badgley (Apr. 24, 1799--March 1, 1881) on Dec. 29, 1815. Their children were Aaron B. (Feb. 19, 1818--Aug. 21, 1819), Jacob (March 14, 1819--Apr. 6, 1862), William H. (Nov. 19, 1820--Jan. 21, 1875), Samuel M. (July 25, 1823--?), Phebe Ann (Sept. 7, 1827--Sept. 29, 1841), George S. (Nov. 25, 1829--Dec. 9, 1881), David Davidson (Nov. 13, 1833--Dec. 15, 1918), Jesse M. (Oct. 4, 1835--Oct. 22, 1839), Sarah Jane (Jan. 14, 1838--Jan. 27, 1842, and Martin H. (Jan. 27, 1840--?). Jacob married Eliza Gordon Aug. 6, 1841; William H. married Nettie Brown on Apr. 6, 1843; Samuel M. married Selina Burke Feb. 6, 1846; Martin H. married Emma Williams March 6, 1862.

David Davidson Price married Harriet McCully (d. 1911; daughter of McCully and Caroline Lum) on Nov. 28, 1861. He was the proprietor of a grocery store on Washington Street, in Newark, NJ. The family boarded actors who appeared at a nearby theater; this is thought to account for the unusual asperations of the children: Lillian, Edgar Dayton, Willard B., Arthur B., and Florence. Lillian, who was a teacher at Newark Normal School, died in her 40s. Edgar (b. 1864), an accountant, writer, advertising pioneer, and singer, died in 1921. Willard was an artist who worked as an illustrator for a New York newspaper and lived for a time in Greenwich Village; the family considered him something of a black sheep, and after he migrated to California they lost track of him. Arthur became secretary to the president of a railroad (the Union Pacific?) and wrote detailed accounts of his worldwide travels; he died in 1961, aged 83. Florence married Horace Beeson; during the 1920s she operated a dressmaking establishment in Shanghai and sold her wares to some of the finest stores in the US; she separated from Horace, who later died; her fortune was wiped out in the crash of 1929; and she lived for the rest of her life with her former secretary, Jane, while studying the relationship between the different parts of the human body so as to develop the perfect system of clothing patterns; she died in 1981 at the age of 99. Edgar was the only one of the five siblings who had children.

Edgar Dayton Price married Frances Smith (Aug. 23, 1874—March 30, 1952) on May 11, 1898. She was the daughter of Wallace Smith (whose father was reputed to have run away from England, for reasons unknown) and Agnes Hulford, but was raised by her Aunt Fannie, a maiden lady with a strong dislike for men. Her courtship with Edgar was stormy; they courted for several years, then broke up for a year during which she cried herself to sleep every night. Finally they got back together and were married. They had two boys, Paul David and Merrill Edgar. Merrill married Mauretta Gladowitz in 1936 and had two boys, Donald and Dayton. Donald is unmarried; Dayton has five children.

Paul David Price (Dec. 8, 1901--Dec. 27, 1982) married Hazel Lillian Loucks (b. June 30, 1904) on Sept. 24, 1938. Hazel is the daughter of Byron Loucks (son of Henry Loucks and Hannah Van de Bogert) and Julia Catherine Meyers (born Oct. 20, 1875, in New Brunswick, NJ--d. 1946; daughter of William Michael Meyers, 1833--1903 and Caroline Elizabeth Langdon, 1844-1888). Paul and Hazel had two children, Paul David, Jr. (b. Apr. 18, 1940), and Holly Elizabeth (b. Dec. 19, 1942). Holly married William H. Sensenig in 1960 and has three children: William, Jr., Donald, and Erin Elisabeth.

Other branches of the family. An address book that seems to be partly in the hand of Frances Smith Price, apparently written around the year 1900, lists several Prices: Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Price, 32 Warren Place, (apparently Newark, NJ; this should be the son of the William H. who died in 1875); M. and Mrs. Frank Price, Roseville, NJ; Mr. and Mrs. L. A. Price, 220 Mt. Pleasant Ave. (apparently Newark); Walter Price, 32 Warren St. (apparently Newark); Mr. and Mrs. Martin Price, Clay County, Kansas (could be the Martin born in 1840); Mr. Samuel Price, Wellsville, Cache County, Utah (the one born in 1823 or his son?); and Mr. and Mrs. Sam Price, of New Vernon, NY (ditto). In 1918 and 1919, Edgar exchanged two or three letters with an E. D. ("Dave") Price who was superintendent of schools in Enid, Oklahoma. He called Edgar "cousin," and referred to "Uncle Dave," who must have been David D. He arrived in Oklahoma around 1902 and married there; he had six children, named Mary Andrey, Kenton, Eloise, Betty, Lowell, and Jean.
