DESCRIPTION

Ben Grauer Collection on French Political, Legal, Economic, and Social History, 1544-1930.

The Grauer collection consists of documents, manuscripts, letters, chapbooks, engravings, photographs, drawings, offprints, and clippings, and broadly covers French political, legal, economic, and social history, from the 16th to the early 20th century. Topics include local government, civil law, and the administration of Departements du Nord, Gironde and Isere; also included are certificates of baptism, residence, identification, and the arrest of emigres. Other subjects include civil lawsuit opinions and verdicts, inheritance and succession issues, deeds, land titles, powers of attorney, and French Army military service and pension records, 1710-1815. Other items and subjects include 1781 census data for Albania and Dalmatia, an 1803 renovation contract for a chateau, and a 1735 bishops' address to the king; also, a chapbook quoting Voltaire on women and Christianity, a post-1810 manuscript on the Jesuits, a Le Brun de Rabot genealogy, 1826, student recommendations, and an 18th century essay on freedom of the press. Items are mainly in French; some Italian. A few documents are on vellum.
